Basically the Past President ensures the continuance of positive club traditions. They will keep the president informed about what has happened in the past, and provide advice on what a president can and should do and when. Often, they are also the club rules of order chairperson. The past president is an invaluable resource. Use these resources to help create a positive team situation.

The Club President typically has the following responsibilities unless the Club House Rules specifically states otherwise which include but are not limited to:

- Provide advice and guidance to the president
- Be the clubs conscience
- Keep the club on track
- Assist club executive as needed
- Ensure all that needs to be done, is done
