This position would benefit from having the role filled by an individual who is familiar with all major club fundraisers, perhaps even having been a chair of one or more,

A person wishing to hold the position of Service Director should have or wish to further develop a skill set which includes: organizational skills, community networking, an ability to public speak and field questions. This role would benefit from someone who is a self-starter and motivational.

The Service Director typically has the following responsibilities unless the Club House Rules specifically states otherwise which include but are not limited to:

- Review current fundraising efforts
- Look for new and exciting venues and ways to earn Service Dollars
- Work closely with the Service Director and individual committee chairs
- Assist Committee Chairs with project proposal including budget and other financial impact
- Ensure proposed projects are viable from a manpower perspective
- Network with other clubs within their zone or other service clubs within the community
